### **536 LOTTERY POLICY FOR CHARTER SCHOOL ADMISSIONS**

The Charter School Board of Directors will designate a lottery date each year. This date will be published on our website, in our weekly newsletter to families, and via email communications to families.

The Charter School Dean of Students will accept applications for enrollment until the number of applications exceeds the capacity of the program, class, grade, level, or building. For students wanting immediate enrollment after the lottery date, they will have their application for enrollment processed when an enrollment position becomes available.

The School Director, Dean of Students, and Board Chairperson will witness and certify the lottery process as part of a Wolf Creek School Board meeting.

If on the lottery date the number of applications exceeds the enrollment spaces for the following academic year, then student enrollment positions will be determined by lot after preferences have been given to certain students. The lottery will consist of a numerical system assigned to each application and chosen from random draw in a public meeting held at the charter school campus.

The charter school will give equal preference to the categories of: sibling of an enrolled pupil and foster child(ren) of that pupil's parents; and to children of the charter school's staff.

The charter school will not limit admission of pupils on the basis of intellectual ability, measure of achievement or aptitude, or athletic ability and may not establish any criteria or requirements for admission that are inconsistent with MN Statute 124E.11 pertaining to Admissions Requirements and Enrollment for Charter Schools.
