Activities Participation Procedure

Wolf Creek Charter School does not offer MSHSL activities and does encourage students to work with other districts to participate in these activities.

To participate in another school district in a MSHSL activity, a student/family is required to contact the Activities or Athletic Director and request a formation of a cooperative agreement. Be advised that most schools are not willing to form such an agreement.

Wolf Creek cannot cooperate unless district or school offering sports is willing to enter into a cooperative agreement.

TRIO Wolf Creek Distance Learning Charter School requires that a student interested in participating in a MN State High School League sanctioned activity through a cooperative agreement meet the following requirements:

- First and foremost, the student should connect with the Activities or Athletic Director at the school they want to participate at to receive approval.
- The student must notify TRIO Wolf Creek of their intent to participate in sports at least 60 days prior to the first practice of the sport/activity.
- The student must pay \$50 when completing the intent to play notice for the paperwork involved in registering with the MSHSL for individual sports. This is a non-refundable fee.
- The student must be eligible to play based on academic GPA and by fulfilling any sanctions against them with the MSHSL prior to practicing or playing sports through the cooperative agreement.
- All other fees pertaining to sports/activities will apply to any TRIO Wolf Creek student participating through any school entity.

Please note that not all sports or activities are eligible for formation of a cooperative agreement due to class size limitations.
