2022 SUMMER SCHOOL/CREDIT RECOVERY DETAILS

Wolf Creek has contracted with Chisago Lakes Schools Alternative Learning Program (ALP) to provide credit recovery during summer term. All registrations, enrollments, and credit earned will be shown as Chisago Lakes ALP but all courses will be delivered online 24/7 through Wolf Creek.

Summer Session 1: June 14-July 12 (Campus open 8:00 am - 12:30 pm on June 14, 21, 28, July 12)

Summer Session 2: July 13 - August 9 (Campus open 8:00 am - 12:30 pm on July 19, 26, and August 2)

Session 2 enrollment requires admin approval. Only students graduating after completion will be allowed.

To be eligible for the summer school/credit recovery program, students must have previously failed the class to take that same class. Students must meet a 20% face-to-face or virtual time requirement as needed. Students must complete a Continual Learning Plan with their Learning Manager to secure registration. Please contact your Learning Manager today if you are interested in taking a summer credit recovery course.
