There are four different levels to the course, all of which offer different challenges. 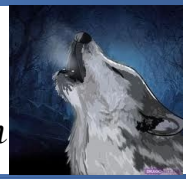

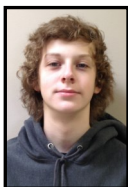

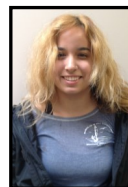
